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SUBJECT: Use of Food, Drinks, and Tobacco Products

The purpose of this policy is to establish guidelines regarding the consumption of food, drinks, and tobacco products (i.e., dipping or smokeless devices like electronic cigarettes) in classrooms and other instructional areas.

No consumption of food, drinks, or tobacco products by students is permitted in the Fasken Learning Resource Center or AFA Wagner & Brown Auditorium. It is the responsibility of instructors who teach in labs or classrooms with delicate equipment to establish policies regarding beverage consumption in these areas.

Instructors in any area are allowed to consume non-alcoholic beverages in their classrooms if necessary; however, instructors utilizing classrooms in the above areas are encouraged to use good judgment regarding their own beverage consumption.

Subject to the approval of the instructor, student may consume non-alcoholic beverages in all other classrooms.

The consumption of food is discouraged in any classroom.

The consumption of tobacco products is forbidden in any College facility or vehicle.

It is the responsibility of the instructors to promote a clean classroom environment. If the classroom is not clean upon entering, instructors should report the problem to a division dean. Students should be asked to check the area around their desks before leaving.
